Bug Drawings

Step 1: Collect Materials

- Paper for artwork
- Pencil
- Eraser
- Options for Color (colored pencils, crayons, markers, or watercolor paint)
- Fine or medium tip black sharpie




Step 2: Bug

- Decide what kind of bug you'd like to draw!
- Consider the shapes that you see in the bug's body (circles, triangles, rectangles, etc)
- Also consider what makes this specific bug unique (flying, camouflaging, hunting, etc)




Step 3: Start your drawing!

- With your pencil, **lightly** sketch your bug
- Note: In this picture on the right, you can hardly see the pencil lines- that's because we need to draw lightly enough to erase if we need to
- Make sure to fill your paper!



Step 4: Outline

- In marker, outline the shape of your bug.
- Sharpies work best
- Take your time!



Step 5: Paint/Color Spaces

- To give your bug a unique look, color it!
- If you're painting with multiple colors, make sure that one color has dried before moving on to the next color.
- For example, in this ladybug, you would paint the black circles first, then fill in the rest with red after the black has dried.
